Dear Experimentalia members,

Member of Experimentalia? Yes, that's you! By joining Experimentalia, you will be co-creating our annual gathering: Le Feu au Lac 2025. Experimentalia is a Geneva-based association for the promotion of culture and art, inspired by Burning Man's 10+3 principles.

This year's theme is Syzygy. "Syzygy" is the coming together of what is usually disconnected.

In astronomy, a syzygy is the alignment of three celestial bodies, such as the Earth, Moon and Sun during an eclipse. In psychology, syzygy is the union of disparate aspects of the self, such as conscious and unconscious, rational and irrational, or id and ego. In some variants of Gnostic philosophy, syzygies are pairs of creatures called Aeons, the first beings to emanate from the creator of all things. They include: depth and silence; spirit and truth; stillness and mixture; essential nature and pleasure, among others.

What will you bring? How will you combine it with what's not usually aligned? Join us and find out.

The full moon will be on August 9 at 7:55 am, the day of the Man Burn. In addition to the full moon, a planetary alignment will occur on August 11, 2025. Mercury, Jupiter, Venus, Uranus, Neptune and Saturn will be aligned.

Le Feu au Lac is an event of Experimentalia, a non-profit association run entirely by volunteers.

Fees are set freely, covering a minimum amount to guarantee the smooth running of the event. We encourage you to support our artistic projects and the running of our organization by adding the amount of your choice when purchasing your ticket.

We had too much fun with this section (Aka weird names we came up with):

Okay so we have been having a lot of fun 'naming' things Swiss styles, and there may be some words in this document that are confusing. Here's a brief dictionary:

Feu au Lac: That's our burn! "Feu au lac" translates to "the lake is on fire". In Swiss Romande, "The lake is not on fire" is a common phrase which is intended to reassure people that there are no emergencies and there's probably no need to rush. We hope to make things a bit unexpected, so we are the Feu au Lac.

 La Patrouilles: Known in other burns as "Rangers" our Patrouilleur.e.s are there to keep everyone safe and help folks that aren't feeling well

La Douane: Known in other burns as "Gate" this is where we check you in, give you an explanation of what kind of crazy event we're running, and introduce you to our principles.

 Shifts: It means 'volunteering' but it's so much more. Burns work because there are no spectators – everyone helps us build together. Taking a shift is a great way to meet people, help build the event and the community, and ensure that we have enough people to make the Feu au Lac run.

Gestionnaire de Papaye: originated In Afrikaaburns (south African burn). Worn by the person who has to handle any major problem.

CHAPTER I : GET NVOLVED

The magic of burn lies in co-creation. Experience it for yourself by finding a project and getting involved! Here are a few ways to get involved:

Bring art:

Everyone is free to bring whatever art they like. The only limitations are:

Art involving fire must use the designated fire pit north of the chalet in the field. No fires elsewhere unless authorized by the fire warden.

Wood can be found in the surrounding forests.

Please don't forget to communicate:

- the size (please let us know about large projects so we can find you a space),
- the noise (please take into account noise levels in different areas for your projects needs... see the section on "noise" below for more detail).

There are several locations available :

- The Artefactum: at the edge of the site, a large (almost) flat space for outdoor artistic projects requiring large surfaces.
- Le Refuge: A magnificent two-storey chalet with a beautiful central wooden staircase. There are plenty of spaces to which you can add magic with a little decoration. There will also be some relaxation areas that could benefit from a little art. Let us know if you have something fun to share!
- Outside: Got something interesting that doesn't require a flat space? There's a wooded area and some space near the campground and La Tanière. Let us know if you'd like to place something so we can reserve a space for you.
- + La Tanière (Den): A space designed to be calm and relaxing. If you

have a project that matches this energy, this is the right place.

- La Faille (the Rift) et Solaris: Two dance floors, one nocturnal and the other for the day. If you're a DJ, musician, VJ or other artist who wants to get people moving, sign up here: <u>https://tinuurl.com/ymbawd5m</u>
- The Velvet Void: If you have an 18+ project... it's in this space dedicated to pleasure that you'll have to settle. Access to the Velvet Void is not permitted to underage participants
- Les Lucioles (The Fireflies): This space is for children's (and older children's) projects.

All participants are also welcome to adopt a space and decorate it to their liking, as much or as little as they wish :) (see section 3. "orphan ideas")

CHAPTER II: ARRIVAL

Location: Chalet Scout du Montperreux

Le Feu au Lac 2025 will take place at **Chalet scout du Montperreux, 2052 Fontaines.** Links to some maps here:

The distance from the Vue des Alpes parking lot to the chalet is around 1.7 km. Allow about 25 minutes on foot. We will coordinate hours for people who need to drop things off, or arrange a shuttle. **There is not parking on site.**

Only people with an RV/Van pass can park on the site. Others are asked to park at the public parking "la Vue des Alpes" (it's free). Thank you for your understanding.

Unfortunately, there are no parking spaces available on the event site other than for the RV/Van passes. The road leading to the site is quite narrow **and it is nearly impossible to have cars passing each other in 2 directions.** So to ease things for people who want to drop things off we have a little system:

- 1st half of every hour (e.g. 2-2:30): IN. You can come drop things off. No exit from the site permitted.
- 2nd half of every hour (e.g. 2:30-3): **OUT**. To allow people who dropped things off to leave the site. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE ROAD IN A CAR AT THIS TIME, IT WILL CAUSE A HUGE MESSY TRAFFIC JAM.

To simplify things, we ask that as much as possible you carpool your stuff that needs to arrive in a car. Fewer cars that need to come and go the better. **Else please use the public parking on la Vue des Alpes**. The public parking is free. We ask you to please not "burnerise" the parking to avoid undue attention. Let's stay incognito (no music, camping, decorations) in the public parking lot. The parking lot is a 25 minute walk from the Montperreux chalet.

Please note that parking along the forest road leading to the estate is not permitted. You may see a few local vehicles as there's a fork in the road. But don't park there. The commune has made it clear that respect for the parking lot was their highest priority.

They warned us of patrols with fines. Please help us keep this event safe, police and trouble-free.

Public transport

What's sexier than ecology? Luckily, Le Feu au Lac is served by public transport. We encourage you to use this mode of transport. The nearest train stop is "La chaud de Fonds". Then take bus 370 La Chaux-de-Fonds - Vuedes-Alpes. (Note: there's only a few 370 bus per day).

The chalet is about a 25-minute walk from this stop. If you have heavy or difficult-to-carry equipment, please write to (etincelle@experimentalia.org) and we will find a solution.

List of things to bring

Sun cream

- Flashlight (it gets dark at night)
- Earplugs
- F Insect repellent spray
- Food+ what you need to cook (kitchen available nut no cutlery or glasses)
- Drinks, drinking water (The water available from the taps is not drinkable. It comes from a cistern and is not suitable for drinking. To be consumed, it must be either boiled or treated with "Micropur").
- If you sleep in a dormitory: sheets or inner sheet or sleeping bag
- + Your own cup + plates, cutlery
- Costumes, bold outfits :) (think radical self expression)
- 🔶 Things to share

Resell your membership

CHAPTER III: SLEEPING

Camp Syzygy

The campsite is located in the center of the terrain on its flattest area. You are free to set up as you wish (with due respect for your neighbors).

Dormitories

Dormitories are located inside the chalet. On the second floor, the chalet is equipped with 50 beds divided into five dormitories. Each bed has its own storage shelf (a locker without a door). Chalet guests requested to bring a sleeping bag and, if desired, a mattress cover, pillow and pillowcase.

Sleeping places are distributed as follows:

- + One 10-bed dormitory with bunkbeds
- Two 8-bed dormitories with bunkbeds (including 1 reserved for families) One 20-bed dormitory with bunkbeds. From this dormitory, access to the outside is possible (with an emergency exit).
- There is also one 4-bed dormitory with bunkbeds that is planned to be a 'chill space'. Please do not set up your things there.

Blankets/linens are not included in the dormitory, so please be sure to bring your own sheets, /blankets, and inner sheet or sleeping bag.

Vans

The van site is located along the road. Due to high demand, space between vans may be limited. We therefore ask you not to plan for any external structures that take up too much space. (awnings, etc).

Only people with an RV/van pass can park on site. Others are asked to park at the public parking Vue des Alps (it's free).



CHAPTER IV: EATING

Use of the chalet's kitchen is available. It is well-stocked with cooking equipment (pots, pans, knives, etc) but we ask that you bring your own plate/bowl/cup for eating. We suggest that you bring as much food as possible that does not require a refrigerator (due to limited space). We are open to culinary projects to feed a bunch of people and have art grants for this, so please write to us if you would like to do this!

Attention : The tap water is not potable.

If you have a food/drink-related project, please write to us at <u>art@experimentalia.org</u> with details.

CHAPTER V: SECURITY

Recognizing the tribe

Each participant will be wearing a wristband that will enable you to recognize them as burners. La Patrouille also patrols for this purpose. If you see someone without a wristband in the space, ask them to leave (this is a private event). If they don't cooperate, call the La Patrouille.

Please note that, as much as we love our bare- assed tribe members, nonsexualized nudity is only permitted in closed spaces (Velvet Void).



Minors will be given a different-colored wristband to prevent them from entering areas reserved for over-18s.

Health

In the event of mental or physical health problems, the Patrouille will direct you to the place appropriate according to your needs.

We have an on-call doctor system, available to the Patrouille, to initiate prehospital care in life-threatening emergencies, assess complex cases and assist with referral decisions.

In case of a life-threatening emergency, call 144 directly.

At the same time, ask someone to call la Patrouille (h24). This enables us to activate the doctors on site and ensure that the way is clear for the ambulance (role of the *Gestionnaire de Papaye*). If you need to keep a medicine refrigerated, don't hesitate to contact the organization team in advance (etincelle@experimentalia.org).

Hygiene

WC and sanitary facilities are located in the basement of the chalet. A separate room with a door is available for washing. Although there is no shower as such, a sanitary facility with hot water is available for having a wash.

Two portable toilet cubicles will be installed at the back of the field *just to* give the campers a closer toilet. Thank you once again for respecting nature and leaving no trace by relieving yourself only in the toilets.

Attention: the water in the taps is not potable.

We will provide toilet paper in the bathrooms, but please bring your own towels and shampoo if you plan to wash on-site.

Fire

The effigy will burn on Saturday at 11pm. Please follow the Fire Warden's instructions and stay within the safety perimeter **according to their safety instructions. For fires, use the designated fire pit north of the chalet in the field. No fires permitted elsewhere**, unless authorized by the fire warden. Wood may be found in the surrounding forests.

Personal fires are not permitted, with the exception of art projects that have requested prior permission from the fire manager (<u>art@experimentalia.org</u>). We are all responsible for preserving our natural surroundings.

Physical/mental health and safety

- Physical safety: in the event of a breach of consent or verbal or physical aggression, please contact La Patrouille immediately. We are all responsible for the safety of our community.
- Please do not let anyone from outside Feu au Lac into the event areas. Each participant has a wristband that you can use to identify burners. La Patrouille is also there to help control this. If you see someone without a wristband in the spaces, ask them to leave (this is a private event). If they don't cooperate, call La Patrouille.
- Police: if you come across the police, do not interact. Call La Patrouille or a member of the fORGe who will notify le Gestionnaire de Papaye.
- Mental health and safety: during burns, it's normal to sometimes feel negative or overwhelming emotions. If you need help, don't hesitate to call La Patrouille. If you need a moment of calm, the chill space is open 24/24 and you can go there to rest.

Sacred cows: don't bother the cows or you will have bad karma forever.

Noise

The noisy zone includes the campsite, the Dayfloor stage area with noise up to 80 dB and up to max. 11 p.m. and the Faille (rift) offsite with noise up to 93 dB and max. 6 a.m. Entirely music-free hours are from 6a.m. to 1 p.m. The speakers face away from the campsite at the Faille and it should remain quiet where people are sleeping.

Pets

Despite our love for our dogs, cats, chickens and other companions, they are unfortunately not allowed on the site. We share this site with a herd of cows, and it's our duty to make life easy for them.

The field next to the campsite and the paths cross a field of cows, which can end up very close to participants. They're relatively calm and accustomed to humans, but please don't bother them.



Children

As an inclusive event, there are no restrictions on children's participation. That said, as we don't know at this stage what participants will bring and organize at the event, we can't say in advance whether the event is suitable for "not-yet-adults".

Especially as this assessment may also vary from one parent to another. You may not be comfortable with your children witnessing certain things. If you've never been to a burn, we suggest you experience it without your children first, so you can make an informed decision for your next one. Please note that minors are not allowed in sex positive spaces.

The physical site is unfortunately not totally safe. **There's a cliff** in one corner of the site. We will of course block off this dangerous part and mark it as best we can, but be aware that the danger persists.

Can you guarantee that you'll be able to keep your child away from this area for the duration of the event?
